New Business:

Recycling Fundraiser – A discussion was held about the possibility of having the Robotics program take over the recycling fundraiser. Members felt it was fair that, since the robotics club does most of the work, they should receive the profit. It was requested that if Robotics, at any point in time, can't keep the fundraiser going, that they let the SSC know, as it is definitely a fundraiser that needs to remain intact.

Donation Requests – We have received donation requests from FPMS Lock-In and the Batter Up Dance. We will give both groups some items. Total value to be approximately \$75-\$100/each.

Community Facilities Workshop – Melissa Klein (board member) shared information about the facilities planning committee. She said 70 people attended the first meeting and most were supportive. There is a great deal of information on the district website. There will be a follow up meeting, scheduled for March 19th at FPMS. At this time, the board is looking to hopefully have a referendum on the November ballot.

Old Business

Saber Den – The new flannel pjs have been quite popular. The original order of 12 sold and the new order has arrived. We want to try to sell some of the Saber Country signs that we have. Possible ideas included selling at: fall sports meeting on May 22, FYF meeting on March 14, and at the bake sale being held at SWG on March 3. Jan is looking for someone to take over volunteer scheduling for this for next year.

Committee Reports

Winterlude – Winterlude dance sold 350 tickets at \$5/each. A discussion was had about possibly trying to make some changes for next year – possibly promoting it for younger grades, trying to make it a black light dance, or possibly having it be a theme-type dance (i.e., hoe down, sweat pants, etc.) It was suggested to possibly survey staff and students to get their input.

Prom – butter braids will be sold for \$12. Profit is \$5/braid sold. Braids will be baked and sold during p/t conferences (March 13). Pick up will be March 22 from 4:30 – 9:00 p.m. Profits for the cell phone

fundraiser was \$258 and \$250 from Culvers. Jan Coenen plans to continue to collect cell phones throughout the school year. She will turn them in next year and profits will go to the prom committee at that time.

Next Spirit Club meeting is scheduled for March 19th, but Jan Coenen is looking into the possibility of moving this to March 26th due to the facilities planning meeting being held on the 19th.
