1. Linda Witkowski, of the Educational Foundation of Franklin Public Schools, spoke to their purpose: raise funds for schools that is not part of the regular budget. They are governed by a Board of Directors and they do not contribute toward capitalized funding. Their donations are \$250-\$100,000. They provide funding for the technology room and the tv tech room. They hold special events to help raise funds, the educational walk, the auction, golf event, and business direct contributions. Linda spoke specifically to the Auction and Casino Night Dinner being held Friday November 13th at the Boerner Botanical Gardens. Please note contributions can also be made through volunteering, company matching and attending the events.

13. Andrea faxed her list for set up and requests of the janitorial staff and Don acknowledge that she did an excellent job.
14. We will have two large boxes for Hunger Task force as we continue the tradition from last year and the boxes will be at the end of each of the ticket tables. The winner will be drawn at half time and must be present to win. The prize is \$100.00 gift card.
