Saber Spirit Club Volunteer Opportunities

Membership in the Saber Spirit Club provides a variety of volunteer opportunities. Below is a brief description of the activities that are a part of Saber Spirit Club.

Please check the committee(s) you might be interested in joining. Please note this is not a commitment; you will be contacted to check your availability.

Homecoming Floats and Parade

As a part of the Homecoming Committee, volunteers are needed to coordinate the construction of parade floats created by the students of each class level. Our volunteers also assist with vehicle and route coordination, security/traffic, signage and communication on parade day.

Homecoming Concessions

SSC runs concessions during the Homecoming football game. Help is needed for set up, selling during the game, and clean up. These responsibilities are shared in shifts.

Homecoming Dance

The Homecoming Dance is held Saturday night of Homecoming weekend at the high school. This part of the committee helps decorate the gym and serves beverages at the dance.

WI Education Fair

This is held in the fall, one volunteer is needed to coordinate the catering of a dinner and a dessert for the college representatives attending. Additional volunteers participate to bake desserts.

Teacher / Custodian Appreciation

Volunteers are needed to coordinate the catering of a lunch for the teachers, staff and custodians of Franklin High School. This event is normally held on a staff development day in January or February. Additional volunteers participate to bake desserts.

Prom Preview

This event is a preview of prom fashions and the prom theme held in the high school gym approximately one month prior to prom. A committee of volunteers helps to plan the event, coordinate vendors and featured fashions, solicit donations for raffle prizes, plan with student participants, and assist during the event.

Post Prom

This late night "safe gathering" is held immediately following prom. Volunteers are needed to plan the event, solicit donations for prizes, serve food and beverages, set-up and clean-up, and assist with security during the evening.

Scholarship Committee

This committee of volunteers is responsible for reviewing and scoring scholarship applications and selecting scholarship recipients.

Senior Yearbook Night

The final event of the year for SSC is a senior yearbook signing party held in May. Volunteers are needed to coordinate this event including providing food, beverages, and decorations along with chaperoning this memorable event. Additional volunteers participate to bake desserts.

A computer savvy volunteer is needed to update our SSC website throughout the year including general maintenance and connection to the FHS homepage.

Saber Den

A volunteer to oversee scheduling volunteer help in the den at activities and events, work along with the treasurer to order and track inventory of apparel, and suggest new opportunities to promote Saber spirit wear.

Throughout the year we support our events by providing homemade baked goods for attendees.
